2. Reasons for the revision

With respect to the forecasts of the consolidated financial results for the fiscal year ended March 31, 2021, net sales are expected to outpace the previous forecast due to steady performance of functional ingredients with health-promoting benefits and solid household demand for products such as yogurt. Operating income, ordinary income, and profit attributable to owners of parent are also expected to outpace the previous forecasts, reflecting improvement in the product mix through expansion of high-margin businesses and products, growth of overseas business, Group-wide cost reviews amid the COVID-19 pandemic, and other factors.

Note: The aforementioned financial results forecasts have been prepared based on information available to the Company as of the date on which this document was released. Consequently, actual results may vary with respect to the forecast amounts due to various unforeseen factors
